Following the launch of the project “Quantifying the Impact of European Food Banks – From Farm to Fork” during the kick-off meeting on the 2 March 2020, the first online Workshop for the Pilot Group will take place virtually on 6-7 April 2020.

In this session we go into more detail with the topic of KPIs by asking ourselves three questions:

1. What do we have? - which indicators Food Banks already measure today;
2. What indicators are we missing? - with respect to the areas of impact we want to monitor, which are the sets of indicators that we consider inadequate, problematic, absent;
3. What can data look like once operationalized in the database? - we will bring some platform’s web frame proposal.

We invited representatives from the manufacturing and distribution sectors to attend the session with the aim of sharing their vision and experience.
